

Qualification Standards for the Appointment of Master’s and Doctoral Degree Examination Committee Members

[Doctoral Degree] According to Article 5 of the “Graduate Degree Examination Regulations of National Taiwan University of Science and Technology”:

Qualification for Doctoral Degree Examination Committee Members	Department-Specific Qualification Standards
(1) Current or former professors or associate professors.	
(2) Academicians of Academia Sinica, or current/former researchers or associate researchers at Academia Sinica.	
(3) Holders of a doctoral degree with significant academic achievements.	Must meet one of the following conditions: 1. Published or had accepted at least one paper in SCI (including SCI Expanded), SSCI, or AHCI journals in the past three years. 2. Previously appointed as a doctoral degree examination committee member under this qualification standard.
(4) Experts in rare or specialized academic disciplines with notable academic or professional achievements.	Must meet one of the following conditions: 1. Published or had accepted at least two papers in SCI (including SCI Expanded), SSCI, or AHCI journals in the past three years. 2. Previously appointed as a doctoral degree examination committee member under this qualification standard. 3. Holds a doctoral degree and has served or is currently serving at an administrative agency, foundation, academic research institution, a publicly listed company, or a OTC-listed company.

[Master’s Degree] According to Article 6 of the “Graduate Degree Examination Regulations of National Taiwan University of Science and Technology”:

Qualification for Master's Degree Examination Committee Members	Department-Specific Qualification Standards
(1) Current or former professors, associate professors, or assistant professors.	
(2) Academicians of Academia Sinica, or current/former researchers, associate researchers, or assistant researchers at Academia Sinica.	
(3) Holders of a doctoral degree with significant academic achievements.	Must meet one of the following conditions: 1. Published or had accepted at least one paper in SCI (including SCI Expanded), SSCI, or AHCI journals in the past five years. 2. Previously appointed as a master's degree examination committee member under this qualification standard.
(4) Experts in rare, specialized academic disciplines or professional practice with notable academic or professional achievements.	Must meet one of the following conditions: 1. Published or had accepted at least two papers in SCI (including SCI Expanded), SSCI, or AHCI journals in the past five years. 2. Previously appointed as a master's degree examination committee member under this qualification standard. 3. Holds a doctoral degree and has served or is currently serving at an administrative agency, foundation, academic research institution, a publicly listed company, or , a OTC-listed company.

Note: If the proposed committee member is not a full-time faculty member of the university, the student must submit supporting documentation verifying the committee member's qualifications at the time of applying for the oral examination. Only those who meet the above qualifications will be eligible to serve as degree examination committee members.
